## Interested in starting a trade career?

Doorways 2 Civil Construction Gladstone is a partnership initiative between local High Schools, McCosker Contracting Pty Ltd, Education Queensland, and Construction Skills Queensland. The program aims to develop baseline skills for young people in school wanting to enter the industry. Students are exposed to the necessary pre-requisite qualifications needed to pursue further training and career pathways in a variety of civil construction fields.

Students are on site one day per week from 7.30am to 3.30 pm working with a variety of mentors at McCosker Contracting performing real tasks in real contracting situations.

Students in D2CC are enrolled in a Certificate I in Resource & Infrastructure Operations which is an entry qualification for careers in civil construction and mining industries amongst others.

Year 10 students remain enrolled at their base school and attend the program 1 day/week.

Students must commit to 2 weeks approved work experience some of which may occur during school holidays.

## Course Structure

Training through the D2CC program will develop a rigorous understanding of the following key areas:

- Basic Skills
- Safety
- Concrete
- Pipes
- Roads/Earthworks
- Employability Skills

## The D2CC training program incorporates:

- Project Employment Modules
- Project Modules – Comprising of an agreed number of individual work site projects which are delivered at the work site. This comprises of 2 parts:
  - » Training Modules
  - » Work Modules
- Project Incident/Accident Module
- Structured Workplace Learning Module
- National White Card – CPCCOHS1001A – General site safety requirement
- First Aid Course

## How do I apply to join the Doorways 2 Civil Construction program?

Application forms are available from the EQIP Gladstone website [www.eqipgladstone.com.au](http://www.eqipgladstone.com.au) or by contacting Gladstone State High School directly. Applications must be accompanied by a current resume, teacher references and school results.

Acceptance into the program is highly competitive. Once accepted, students are required to comply with site security, safety and school rules. Any breeches can result in instant dismissal from the program.

## What will I require if I am accepted into Doorways to Civil Construction?

Complete site and safety inductions

- Annual materials fee paid to base school;
- Commitment to at least 2 weeks approved work experience;
- Steel toe capped boots, long pants and belt supplied by the student

## What will it cost?

Students selected to participate in the program will be required to contribute to course costs via a student levy. The annual cost of covers administration costs, work experience, National White Card, First Aid Certificate, training resources and an excursion. This is to be paid to your base school.
